13	the printing of a cumulative supplement to the most recent volume of school laws immediately after the
14	conclusion of any session of the legislature at which new school laws or amendments to the school laws
15	were adopted. It shall The supplement must be offered and sold at cost of the printing and shipping to any
16	school official or other person.
17	(7) if deemed considered necessary, publish a biennial report of the superintendent of public
18	instruction;
19	(8) counsel with and advise county superintendents on matters involving the welfare of the schools
20	and, when requested, give a county superintendent a written answer to any question concerning school
21	law;
22	(9) call an annual meeting of the county superintendents when he deems it considered to be
23	advisable;
24	(10) as far as he shall find it when considered to be practicable, address public assemblies on
25	subjects pertaining to education in Montana; and
26	(11) faithfully work in all practical and possible ways for the welfare of the public schools of the
