Fiscal Note for HB0243, as introduced

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing licensed electricians to renew a lapsed state license without examination within 1 year of the license expiration date upon payment of renewal and delinquency fees.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There are approximately 492 lapsed master and journeymen electrician licenses that could be reinstated. It is projected that 20 lapsed licensees will request reinstatement.
- 2. A delinquency fee will be established by administrative rule.
- 3. Operating expenses will be minimal in FY96 and can be covered by the authority included in the Executive Budget present law base recommendation.
- 4. State special revenue is projected to increase by \$1,700 in FY96 only.
