13	and, if convicted by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be fined <u>an amount</u> not <u>to exceed \$500 or be</u>
14	imprisoned in the county jail for any term not to exceed 6 months, or both less than \$10 or more than
15	\$100 .
16	(2) As used in this section, "disturbs" means:
17	(a) quarreling, challenging to fight, or fighting;
18	(b) making loud or unusual noises;
19	(c) using threatening, profane, or abusive language;
20	(d) discharging firearms, except at a shooting range during established hours of operation;
21	(e) rendering the free ingress or egress to public or private places impassable;
22	(f) disturbing or disrupting any lawful assembly or public meeting;
23	(g) transmitting a false report or warning of a fire or other catastrophe in a place where the
24	occurrence would endanger human life;
25	(h) creating a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate
26	purpose; or
27	(i) transmitting a false report or warning of an impending explosion in a place where the occurrence
