14 vehicle, and has a permanent physical disability that impairs mobility when not in a motor vehicle;

15 (b) regardless of whether the person holds a driver's license or owns a motor vehicle, has a
16 permanent physical disability that impairs driving ability and impairs mobility when not in a motor vehicle
17 to such an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination; or

18 (c) has a temporary physical disability that impairs driving ability or mobility when not in a motor
19 vehicle to such an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination

20 (2) The department of justice may issue a special parking permit to an agency or business that
21 provides transportation as a service for persons with a disability. The permit must be used only to load and
22 unload persons with a disability in the special parking place provided for in 49-4-302. As used in this
23 subsection, "disability" means a physical impairment that severely limits a person's ability to walk

24 (3) An applicant may not receive more than one permit."

(b) regardless of whether the person holds a driver's license or owns a motor vehicle, has a permanent physical disability that impairs driving ability and impairs mobility when not in a motor vehicle to an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination; or

(c) has a temporary physical disability that impairs driving ability or mobility when not in a motor vehicle to such an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination.
