BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 49-4-301, MCA, is amended to read:

**"49-4-301. Who eligible for special parking permit.** (1) The department of justice shall issue a special parking permit to a person who:

(a) holds a valid Montana driver's license and owns a motor vehicle, other than a commercial vehicle, and has a permanent physical disability that impairs mobility when not in a motor vehicle;

(b) regardless of whether the person holds a driver's license or owns a motor vehicle, has a permanent physical disability that impairs driving ability and impairs mobility when not in a motor vehicle to such an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination; or

(c) has a temporary physical disability that impairs driving ability or mobility when not in a motor vehicle to such an extent that the person needs to be driven by another person to a destination.

(2) The department of justice may issue a special parking permit to an agency or business that provides transportation as a service for persons with a disability. The permit must be used only to load and unload persons with a disability in the special parking place provided for in 49-4-302. As used in this subsection, "disability" means a physical impairment that severely limits a person's ability to walk.

(3) An applicant may not receive more than one permit."
