9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 13-13-213, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"13-13-213. Transmission of application to election administrator delivery of ballot. (1) Except
13	as provided in subsection (2), the elector shall forward the application by mail or deliver it in person to the
14	election administrator. The election administrator shall compare the signature on the application with the
15	applicant's signature on the registration card. If convinced the individual making the application is the same
16	as the one whose name appears on the registration card, he the election administrator shall deliver the
17	ballot to the elector in person or as otherwise provided in 13-13-214.
18	(2) In lieu of the requirement provided in subsection (1), an elector who requests an absentee ballot
19	pursuant to 13-13-212(3) may return the application to the special absentee election board. Upon receipt
20	of the application, the special absentee election board shall examine the signatures on the application and
21	a copy of the voting registration card to be provided by the election administrator. If the special absentee
22	election board believes that the applicant is the same person as the one whose name appears on the
23	registration card, the special absentee election board shall provide a ballot to the elector."

25	Section 2. Section 13-13-214, MCA, is amended to read:
26	"13-13-214. Mailing ballot to elector. (1) (a) As Except as provided in 13-13-213 and in subsection
27	(1)(b) of this section, as soon as the official ballots are printed, the election administrator shall send by mail,
28	postage prepaid, to each elector from whom he the election administrator has received a valid application
29	whatever official ballots are necessary. Ballots shall <u>must</u> be sent immediately to electors submitting valid
30	requests after the official ballots are printed.

1	(b) The election administrator may deliver a ballot in person to an individual other than the elector
2	<u>if:</u>
3	(i) the elector has designated the individual, either by a signed letter or by making the designation
4	on the application form in a manner prescribed by the secretary of state;
5	(ii) the individual taking delivery of the ballot on behalf of the elector verifies, by signature, receipt
6	of the ballot; and
7	(iii) the election administrator believes that the individual receiving the ballot is the designated
8	person.
9	(2) The election administrator shall enclose with the ballots a self-addressed envelope for the return
10	of the ballots. An affirmation in the form prescribed by the secretary of state shall <u>must</u> be printed on the
11	back of the envelope.
12	(3) The election administrator shall stamp the ballots sent provided to an absentee elector as
13	provided in 13-13-116.
14	(4) Both the envelope in which the ballot is mailed to an elector in the United States service and
15	the return envelope shall <u>must</u> have printed across the face such <u>the</u> information and graphics and be of
16	such a color as may be prescribed by the secretary of state consistent with the regulations established by
17	the federal election commission, U.S. postal service, or other federal agency.
18	(5) If the ballots sent to the elector are for a primary election, the election administrator shall
19	enclose an extra envelope marked "For Unvoted Party Ballot(s)". This envelope may not be numbered or
20	marked in any way so it can be identified as being used by any one elector.
21	(6) Instructions for voting shall <u>must</u> be enclosed with the ballots. Instructions for primary elections
22	must include use of the envelope for unvoted ballots. The instructions must include information concerning
23	the type or types of writing instruments which may be used to mark the absentee ballot.
24	(7) The return envelope shall must be self-addressed to the election administrator."
