Fiscal Note for HB0390, as introduced

<u>DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION</u>: A bill for an act entitled: "an act requiring the Board of Regents to use an amount equal to 5 percent of tuition revenue collected in the previous fiscal year to support the work-study program; amending section 20-25-702 MCA; and providing an effective date."

ASSUMPTIONS:

- The provisions of this bill will apply to the six universities/colleges and the five colleges of technology.
- 2. There are no tuition rate increases in FY96. Increases in total tuition collected are the result of increased numbers and the mix of Western Undergraduate, resident and non-resident students. Tuition revenues are equal to tuition collections net of fee waivers. Net tuition collections are expected to be \$64,542,101 in FY95 and \$66,782,012 in FY96.
- 3. The current state work study program (\$500,000 in FY94) will be included in the revenues for this proposal. The FY96 and FY97 Governor's budget request for work study is adopted by the legislature.
- 4. The current federal work study program (\$2,325,719 in FY94) will not be included in revenues for this proposal.
- 5. The Regents must fund the increased level of work study with reductions in other areas or increases in tuition.

Revenues:

Tuition increases of \$2,574,097 and \$2,672,948 will be required if offsetting reductions are not made in other college, university or college of technology expenditures.

TECHNICAL NOTES: It is not clear in the bill whether state and federal sources of work study may be included to reach the total of 5% of tuition collections. We assume the federal moneys are not included. The inclusion of federal revenues would reduce the fiscal impact significantly.
