"87-1-506. Enforcement powers of wardens. A warden may:

(1) serve a subpoena issued by a court for the trial of a violator of the fish and game laws;

(2) search, without a warrant, any tent not used as a residence, or any boat, vehicle, box, locker, creel, crate, game bag, or package or their contents upon probable cause to believe that any fish game law or department rule for the protection, conservation, or propagation of game, fish, birds, or furbearing animals has been violated;

(3) search, with a search warrant, any dwelling house or other building;

(4) seize game, fish, game birds, and fur-bearing animals and any parts of them taken or possessed in violation of the law or the rules of the department;

(5) seize and hold, subject to law or the orders of the department, devices which that have been used unlawfully take game, fish, birds, or fur-bearing animals;

(6) arrest, in accordance with Title 46, chapter 6, a violator of a fish and game law or rule of the
ment, violation of which is a misdemeanor;

(7) enforce the disorderly conduct and public nuisance laws, {45-8-101 and 45-8-111}, as they relate to the operation of motorboats on all waters of the state;

(8) as provided for in 37-47-345, investigate and make arrests for violations of the provisions of 7, chapter 47, and of any rules adopted pursuant to that chapter relating to the regulation of
