STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

Fiscal Note for HB0487, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act repealing the Montana retail motor fuel marketing act.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The proposed legislation eliminates retail motor fuel dealer price restrictions under current law from subsidized or predatory pricing. Short term price fluctuations and shifts in market shares could result. There is insufficient information available regarding the potential impact on pump prices.
2. The total number of pumps subject to Department of Commerce Weights and Measures inspections would not change.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Due to insufficient information, the fiscal impact to state expenditures and revenues is indeterminable.

A significant change in market concentration could decrease slightly the workload of Department of Commerce Weights and Measures.
