- 3. There will be minimal costs to the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks which can be covered with the existing budget request.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

There will be minimal fiscal impact to the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks.

# TECHNICAL NOTES:

HB746, Chapter 755, Laws of 1991, requires an American Indian monument and tribal flag circle which are being planned for a similar part of the capitol grounds.
