8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **NEW SECTION.** **Section 1. Exemptions.** If the construction of a stadium at Montana state
11 university - Bozeman and the restoration and remodeling of the Prescott house at the university of Montana
12 - Missoula are authorized in House Bill No. 5, the projects are not subject to the requirements of Title 18,
13 chapter 2, except that:

14 (1) the department of administration shall execute the provisions of 18-2-103(1)(a) and (1)(e); and
15 (2) the provisions of Title 18, chapter 2, part 4, apply to all labor other than donated labor.

17 **NEW SECTION.** **Section 2. Coordination.** If House Bill No. 5 does not contain authority for the
18 projects referred to in [section 1], then [this act] is void.

20 **NEW SECTION.** **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
