A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING THE OFFENSE OF CAPITOL DESECRATION; AND REAM

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **NEW SECTION.** Section 1. Desecration of capitol. (1) In this section, "capitol" means the Montana  
12 state capitol building and any permanent monuments on the capitol grounds.

13 (2) A person commits the offense of desecration of the capitol if the person purposely or  
14 knowingly:

15 (a) defiles or defaces the capitol;  
16 (b) places on or attaches to the capitol any mark, design, or material not properly a part of the  
17 capitol; or  
18 (c) injures, damages, or destroys any portion of the capitol.

19 (3) A person convicted of the offense of desecration of the capitol shall be imprisoned in the state  
20 prison for any term not to exceed life or be fined an amount not to exceed \$100,000, or both.

21 (4) This section does not apply to displays or actions authorized by the department of  
22 administration.
