14	legislative council shall assign the question to an appropriate subcommittee as provided in Title 5, chapter
15	5, part 2, or to the appropriate statutorily created committee.
16	(2) The legislative council shall supervise the activities of the council staff.
17	(3) The legislative council shall assist in the preparation and presentation of an orientation for
18	legislators.
19	(3)(4) The legislative council shall assist in the preparation and submission of all standing and select
20	committee and subcommittee reports and recommendations to the legislature.
21	(4)(5) This section shall may not be construed to permit the council to approve or disapprove of
22	any substantive portions or recommendations of a standing or select committee or subcommittee report."

## Fiscal Note for SB0020, as introduced

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act providing that the Legislative Council is responsible for assisting in the preparation and presentation of an orientation for legislators.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Legislature will meet for a one-day orientation in conjunction with the organizational caucuses, with 150 legislators and legislators-elect attending.
- 2. Material packets for 150 legislators and 25 other participants will be \$6 per packet, or \$1,050.
- 3. Reimbursement for salary and expenses would be limited to one day only for orientation. Salary for 150 legislators @ \$57 per day plus benefits would be \$9,840.
- 4. Lodging and meals for one day would be \$7,000 (150 X \$46.70). No mileage would be allowed since the meeting would be in conjunction with the organizational caucuses.
- 5. Equipment rental and miscellaneous costs would be \$200.
