## 10 STATEMENT OF INTENT

11 A statement of intent is required for this bill because 7-4-2905 grants rulemaking authority to the  
12 board of crime control. The rules should provide for:

13 (1) essential training of coroners;

14 (2) a basic training course or its equivalent;

15 (3) continued training courses and education crucial to the professional standards of coroners and  
16 deputy coroners;

17 (4) board review of training schools other than those operated by the state to determine whether  
18 they meet board requirements for training; and

19 (5) board review of exigent circumstances that might allow a waiver of the 2-year time period for  
20 training.

25 **"7-4-2905. Coroner education and continuing education.** (1) Coroner education must be  
26 conducted by the board of crime control. The board may adopt rules establishing standards and procedures  
27 for basic and advanced education. The cost of conducting the education must be borne by the department  
28 of justice from money appropriated for the education. The county shall pay the salary, mileage, and per  
29 diem of each coroner-elect, coroner, and deputy coroner attending from that county.

30 (2) (a) The board shall conduct a 40-hour basic coroner course of study after each general election.

1 The course, or an equivalent course approved by the board, must be completed before the first Monday  
2 in January following the election. The board may conduct other basic coroner courses at times it considers  
3 appropriate.

4 (b) The board shall annually conduct a 16-hour advanced coroner course. ~~Failure~~ Unless there are  
5 exigent circumstances, failure of any coroner or deputy coroner to satisfactorily complete the advanced  
6 coroner course, or an equivalent course approved by the board, at least once every 2 years results in
