16	however acquired by it, which it if the department determines that the property is not necessary to the
17	laying out, altering, construction, improvement, or maintenance of a highway. If the interest is reasonably
18	of a value in excess of <del>\$100 <u>\$2,500</u>, sale <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be made to the highest bidder at public auction. The</del>
19	sale shall of an interest at auction must be conducted as provided in 77-2-321."
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21	Section 2. Section 60-4-203, MCA, is amended to read:
22	"60-4-203. Conduct of sale. (1) The department shall publish notice of the sale once a week for
23	4 successive weeks in a newspaper published in the county in which the interest is located once a week
24	for 4 successive weeks. The notice of sale shall must contain the information required by 77-2-322. Sale
25	shall <u>must</u> be held in the county <del>wherein</del> <u>where</u> the property is located.
26	(2) Before the sale of an interest having a value in excess of \$100 <u>\$2,500</u> , the department <del>shall</del>
27	must have it the interest appraised at a price representing a fair market value. The appraised value shall
28	must be stated in the published notice.
29	(3) A sale of an interest may not be made unless it has been appraised within 3 months prior to
30	the date of the sale. A sale may not be made for less than 90% of the appraised value.

2	the purchase price into the state treasury to the credit of the department."

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising the value threshold at which the Department of Transportation shall offer real property at public auction; eliminating the provision allowing a landowner from whom the Department of Transportation acquires real property to redeem the property at the sale price within 10 days after the sale.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There will be 7 sales per year at or below the value threshold established by SB0114.
- 2. Each sale by public auction costs \$3,500. Each sale without the public auction requirement would cost \$2,500.
- All costs and proceeds associated with excess right-of-way are attributed to the state.
