29	(1) The institution located at Lewistown is the Montana mental health nursing care center for the aged.	
30	The primary function of the center is the care and treatment of persons 55 years of age or older with	

(c) chemical dependency services consisting of appropriate detoxification, inpatient, intensive



mental disorders who require nursing care.	Priority must be given to patients referred from the Montan
state hospital.	

- (2) Appropriate admissions to the Montana mental health nursing care center for the aged are persons who are unable to maintain themselves in their homes or communities due to a mental disorder, as defined in 53-21-102, associated with the aging process, but who do not require the intensity of treatment available at the Montana state hospital.
- (3) Admissions to the center are voluntary or upon transfer from the Montana state hospital. The department of corrections and human services may adopt rules concerning specific admission criteria, treatment, and discharge procedures CONSISTENT WITH [SECTION 4] AND SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SECTION."

Section 4. Section 53 21 412, MCA, is amended to read:

"53 21 412. Transfer of patients between Montana state hospital and Montana mental health nursing care center. (1) With the approval of the department of corrections and human services, Montana state hospital patients may be admitted transferred to the Montana montal health nursing care center upon voluntary application by the patient or the patient's guardian when they meet the center's admission criteria and no longer require active treatment of their mental disorders.

(2) A patient of the Montana mental health nursing eare center who requires the intensity of treatment available at the Montana state hospital may be voluntarily admitted to the Montana state hospital pursuant to 53-21-111 or, involuntarily committed pursuant to 53-21-114 through 53-21-127, or, if subject to a current involuntary commitment, transferred to the Montana state hospital."

NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. ADMISSIONS TO MENTAL HEALTH NURSING CARE CENTER. (1)
THE MONTANA MENTAL HEALTH NURSING CARE CENTER MAY ADMIT PATIENTS ON A VOLUNTARY
BASIS ACCORDING TO ADMISSION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED IN ADMINISTRATIVE
RULES.

(2) A PATIENT INVOLUNTARILY COMMITTED TO THE MONTANA STATE HOSPITAL MAY BE TRANSFERRED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND HUMAN SERVICES TO THE MONTANA MENTAL HEALTH NURSING CARE CENTER IF THE PATIENT MEETS THE ADMISSION CRITERIA OF THE CENTER. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE PATIENT, THE PATIENT'S NEXT OF KIN, AND THE



1	MENTAL DISABILITIES BOARD OF VISITORS AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE THE TRANSFER. IF A PERSON

Section 5. Section 53-21-413, MCA, is amended to read:

"53-21-413. Discharge AND TRANSFER of patients. (1) The superintendent of the Montana mental health nursing care center may authorize the discharge of a patient residing at the center according to rules adopted by the department of corrections and human services. However, no patient may be detained at the center without the consent of the patient or his guardian. RULES ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT GOVERNING DISCHARGE FROM THE CENTER MUST BE CONSISTENT WITH 53-21-111, 53-21-181, AND 53-21-183.

INVOLUNTARILY TRANSFERRED TO THE CENTER HAVE THE RIGHTS PROVIDED IN THIS CHAPTER.

THE MONTANA STATE HOSPITAL MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE MONTANA STATE HOSPITAL IF THE PATIENT IS SUBJECT TO AN INVOLUNTARY COMMITMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE PATIENT, THE PATIENT'S NEXT OF KIN, AND THE MENTAL DISABILITIES BOARD OF VISITORS AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE THE TRANSFER. IF A PERSON OR ENTITY NOTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OBJECTS TO THE TRANSFER, THE PERSON OR ENTITY MAY PETITION THE DISTRICT COURT FOR A HEARING TO REVIEW WHETHER THE TRANSFER IS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE PATIENT. THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION MUST INCLUDE NOTIFICATION OF THE RIGHT TO PETITION THE DISTRICT COURT PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION. NOTICE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE TRANSFER PURSUANT TO 53-21-130."

NEW SECTION. Section 6. Code commissioner instruction. Wherever the term "Montana center for the aged" appears in material enacted by the 54th legislature, the code commissioner is instructed to



1	change the term to the "Montana mental health nursing care center".
