13	(a) at the adjournment of each session of the board, in full and complete detail or in summary form
14	or by reference, with the full and complete text made available on request, a complete list of all claims
15	ordered paid for all purposes, showing the name, purpose, and amount, and a fair summary of the minutes
16	and records of all of its proceedings;
17	(b) annually, The board may publish the county clerk's annual statement of the financial condition
18	of the county, in full and complete detail or in summary form. If the board does not publish the annual
19	statement in complete detail or in summary form, it shall publish a notice that the annual statement is
20	available upon request from the county clerk.
21	(2) Publication in full, in summary, or by reference of such the minutes and records of proceedings
22	must be made within 21 days after the adjournment of the session. Publication of the financial statement
23	or notice of the availability of the financial statement must be made within 30 days after the presentation
24	of the same <u>financial statement</u> to the board. The board shall <u>may</u> not allow or order paid any claim for anγ

Fiscal Note for SB0121, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act eliminating the requirement for publishing the county annual report in a newspaper.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

There would be significant savings to the counties. Publication of annual statements in complete detail can be as many as three newspaper pages for small counties. Cost prohibits most counties from publishing the detailed annual financial report, publishing a summary report instead. This legislation would allow counties to publish a notice that the annual statement is available upon request from the county clerk.
