STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

Fiscal Note for SB0192, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill making the salary of the county attorney training coordinator in the Department of Justice the same as that of a full-time county attorney in a county with a population in excess of 30,000.

ASSUMPTIONS :

- The FY95 base salary (excluding benefits and insurance) for full-time county attorneys, in counties with a population in excess of 30,000, is \$58,076.
 Presently, 14 counties pay this base salary.
- 2. The FY95 base salary for the county attorney training coordinator in the Department of Justice, before the FY95 pay plan adjustment, was \$46,286 (without benefits and insurance). The position is a grade 20. The budgeted salary amounts for this position in the Governor's Executive Budget are \$46,801 in FY96 and \$46,981 in FY97.
- 3. Under present law, county attorneys may receive an annual salary adjustment equal to the previous year increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The recent annual CPI increases have been approximately 3%. A 3% annual increase factor was used for the present law base adjustments in the Governor's Executive Budget for the County Attorney Payroll program (the state general fund pays for half of the salary and benefits for county attorneys). The estimated base salary is \$59,818 for FY96 and \$61,613 for FY97 (58,076 x 1.03 = 59,818; 59,818 x 1.03 = 61,613).
- 4. Benefits for the training coordinator are calculated at 15.7% of salary, excluding the state's insurance contribution that would not be affected by this change.
