12	Section 1. Section 52-2-117, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"52-2-117. Indian child welfare specialist. (1) The director of the department shall appoint a
14	qualified employee of the department person to act as an Indian child welfare specialist.
15	(2) The duties of the specialist include:
16	(1)(a) developing Indian foster homes and other Indian placement resources;
17	(2)(b) providing technical advice to tribal, state, and county agencies and district courts on matters
18	pertaining to Indian child welfare;
19	(3)(c) providing assistance in negotiating cooperative agreements to provide foster care services
20	to Indian children;
21	(4)(d) conducting training seminars on implementing the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 (25
22	U.S.C. 1901, et seq.);
23	(6)(e) applying for and accepting grants and other funds for Indian child welfare activities;
24	(6)(f) developing and maintaining a list of attorneys to represent indigent parents and Indian
25	custodians in Indian child welfare proceedings;
26	(7)(g) making recommendations to the department on legislation and rules concerning Indian child
27	welfare matters; and
28	(8)(h) performing other duties concerning Indian child welfare matters as determined by the
29	director."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Notification of tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send
a copy of [this act] to the tribal chairperson of each of the seven Montana reservations and to the tribal
chairperson of the Little Shell tribe.
NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
