SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 18
Franklin

INTRODUCED BY

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO DEVELOP PERFORMANCE CRITERIA FOR PROGRAM MANAGERS AND TO ADOPT PERSONNEL POLICIES THAT WILL ENSURE THAT APPROPRIATE MANAGEMENT TRAINING IS PROVIDED FOR MANAGEMENT OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, performance audits by the Legislative Auditor's Office have identified the need to strengthen program management at various agencies; and

WHEREAS, the same performance audits have noted limited development of program management information; and

WHEREAS, technical professional staff are promoted into program management positions with limited management background and training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Executive Branch be encouraged to develop performance criteria for program managers and to adopt personnel policies that will ensure that appropriate management training is provided for management officers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send copies of this resolution to the Governor and to the director of each Executive Branch department.
