5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP AND DUTIES OF THE STATE
6 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COUNCIL TO INCLUDE LOCAL GOVERNMENT MEMBERS AND
7 TO PROVIDE A FORUM FOR TECHNOLOGICAL MATTERS INVOLVING BOTH STATE AGENCIES AND
8 LOCAL GOVERNMENTS; AND AMENDING SECTION 2-17-502, MCA."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 **Section 1.** Section 2-17-502, MCA, is amended to read:

13 **"2-17-502. State information technology advisory council.** (1) The department of administration
14 shall create a state information technology advisory council under 2-15-122.

15 (2) The members of the advisory council must be selected from a diverse group in order to
16 adequately represent the interests of state agencies, including the university system, and local
17 governments.

18 (3) In addition to the advisory functions assigned by the department, the ~~information technology~~
19 advisory council shall review statewide information and data processing policies, make recommendations
20 regarding the application of new information processing technology in state government, and advise the
21 department on long-term strategic planning for the use of information processing technology in state
22 government.

23 (4) The advisory council shall also provide a forum to:

24 (a) guide state agencies and local governments in the development and deployment of
25 intergovernmental information resources;

26 (b) encourage cooperative efforts among state agencies and local governments in the development
27 of information resources;

28 (c) develop and recommend to the department standards and policies for intergovernmental
29 information resources; and

30 (d) advise the department in the development of cooperative contracts for the purchase of

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
