# Fiscal Note for HB0057, as introduced

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act granting the Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee the authority to administer the Alfalf Leaf-Cutting Bee Management Act and the Alfalfa Seed Industry Act; expanding the membership of the Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee; eliminating the Alfalfa Leaf-Cutting Be Committee; amending sections 2-15-3004 and 80-6-1102, MCA; repealing section 2-15-3005, MCA; and providing an effective date.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The responsibilities, duties and representation of the Alfalfa Leaf-Cutting Bee Committee will be incorporated into the Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee.
- 2. New section 3 of HB0057 repeals 2-15-3005, MCA, eliminating the Alfalfa Leaf-Cuttin Bee Committee and annual expenses as required in 2-15-3005, MCA.
- 3. The Alfalfa Leaf-Cutting Bee Committee consists of 5 members, 2 of whom are current department employees who have not been receiving per diem, mileage and lodging, leaving a net reduction of 3 committee members.
- 4. Section 1 of HB0057 increases committee membership by 1 of the Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee by allowing the director of the Department of Agriculture or the director's authorized representative to become an authorized voting member of the Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee.
- 5. Elimination of 3 Alfalfa Leaf-Cutting Bee Committee members and one annual two-day meeting will save \$424 per year (3 members x 2 day/meeting x \$25/day = \$150 + 3 members x average 200 miles x .30/mile = 180 + 3 members x 1 night stay x \$31.20 = 94).

9	(12) "Predator" means any organism or insect that preys on, devours, or destroys bees or nests.
10	(13) "Wild trap" means to intentionally trap bees on property not owned or leased by the trapper."

12	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Repealer. Section 2-15-3005, MCA, is repealed.

14	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Transition. [This act] merges the alfalfa leaf-cutting bee committee
15	into the Montana alfalfa seed committee and revises the membership of the Montana alfalfa seed committee
16	to accommodate the merger. Because there are now incumbents holding positions on both committees,
17	the legislature intends for the governor to make membership adjustments when necessary on and after [the
18	effective date of this act), in accordance with 2-15-3004 as amended by [this act].
