11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
12	
13	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Development and implementation of new or modified public employees'
14	retirement system. (1) A committee designated by the legislative council pursuant to 5-5-211 shall design
15	a public employees' retirement plan to replace or modify the current public employees' retirement system
16	provided for in Title 19, chapter 3.
17	(2) The new or modified retirement plan must be designed to provide for the following:
18	(a) increased portability of contributions;
19	(b) increased flexibility to allow plan members a choice in:
20	(i) selecting, from a group of set amounts, the amount of the member's contribution to the
21	retirement plan;
22	(ii) directing investments; and
23	(iii) selecting the form of the benefit payout; and
24	(c) a retirement plan component that will provide for a specified benefit in retirement.
25	(3) In designing the new or modified retirement plan, the committee shall involve employers,
26	employees, members of the current public employees' retirement system, retirement plan administrators,
27	policymakers, and other interested parties.
28	(4) The committee shall establish an implementation schedule for conversion to the new or modified
2 9	retirement plan. The retirement plan design and the implementation schedule, including any implementing
30	legislation, must be presented to the 56th legislature. The retirement plan design and implementation



1	schedule must include but is not limited to:
2	(a) how the new or modified retirement plan is to be administered;
3	(b) the costs associated with the conversion;
4	(c) a timetable for implementation; and
5	(d) a preconversion and postconversion education plan for informing policymakers, administrative
6	staffs, executive staffs, interagency staffs, employers, employees, retirement plan members, taxpayers,
7	and other interested parties about the new or modified retirement plan.
8	(5) The committee may contract for consultant services.
9	
10	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general fund to the
11	legislative services division \$80,000 for use by the committee designated by the legislative council under
12	[section 1].
13	
14	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Coordination instruction. If Bill No [LC 0381] is passed and
15	approved and if it repeals the sunset on the committee on public employee retirement systems, then "A
16	committee designated by the legislative council pursuant to 5-5-211" as it appears in [section 1 of this act]
17	and "the committee designated by the legislative council under [section 1]" as it appears in [section 2 of
18	this act] shall read "the committee on public employee retirement systems".

20	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 1997.

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25	(3) (A) In designing the new or modified retirement plan, the committee shall involve employers,
26	employees, members of the current public employees' retirement system, retirement plan administrators,
27	policymakers, and other interested parties.
28	(B) THE COMMITTEE SHALL ALSO GATHER AND ANALYZE INFORMATION ON THE AMOUNT OF
