A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR DISTRIBUTION TO INDIAN HEALTH CLINICS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Appropriation.** On July 1, 1997, and on July 1, 1998, there is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public health and human services \$150,000 for distribution as a grant of \$30,000 to each of the following Indian health care providers:

- (1) Leo Pocha clinic, Helena;
- (2) Indian health clinic of the Native American center, Great Falls;
- (3) Missoula Indian center, Missoula;
- (4) Billings Indian health board, Billings; and
- (5) Northern American Indian health alliance, Butte.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Coordination instruction.** If House Bill No. 126 is passed and approved and if it includes an appropriation for Indian health clinics, then [this act] is void.

NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective July 1, 1997.
