7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 61-10-126, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "61-10-126. **Deposit of fees.** ~~All fees~~ (1) Fees collected under 61-10-101 through 61-10-104 and
11 61-10-106 through 61-10-125 by the department of transportation or its agent must be forwarded to the
12 state treasurer for deposit in the highway nonrestricted account in the state special revenue fund.

13 (2) Fees collected under 61-10-101 through 61-10-104 and 61-10-106 through 61-10-125 by a
14 county must be forwarded to the county treasurer for deposit in the county road fund.

STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

Fiscal Note for HB0233, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill allowing a county to retain fees for GVW permits issued by a county.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Only revenue from mileage-based permits for overweight movement for a single trip will be affected by this bill. A statistical sampling conducted by the Department of Transportation concluded that of the total overweight mileage permits issued during the sampling period, 5% involved travel on county roads. Assume that overweight mileage permit revenue will decrease by 5%.
2. Overweight trip permit revenue for FY96 was \$1,220,800. Revenue decrease is therefore \$61,000 (5% x \$1,220,800).
