17	(c) allow a person to open an alcoholic beverage container or consume any alcoholic beverage in

19	(2) A vendor's representative or a wine distributor may provide samples of liquor or wine to an
20	agent or an agent's employees but only if the vendor's representative or the wine distributor, the agent,
