9	Section 1. Section 45-7-401, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"45-7-401. Official misconduct. (1) A public servant commits the offense of official misconduct
11	when in his <u>the public servant's</u> official capacity<u>, ho the public servant</u> commits any of the following acts:
12	(a) purposely or negligently fails to perform any mandatory duty as required by law or by a court
13	of competent jurisdiction;
14	(b) knowingly performs an act in his <u>the public servant's</u> official capacity which he <u>that the public</u>
15	servant knows is forbidden by law;
16	(c) with the purpose to obtain advantage for himself <u>the public servant</u> or another, performs an act
17	in excess of his the public servant's lawful authority;
18	(d) solicits or knowingly accepts for the performance of any act a fee or reward which he that the
19	public servant knows is not authorized by law; or
20	(e) knowingly conducts a meeting of a public agency in violation of 2-3-203.
21	(2) A public servant convicted of the offense of official misconduct shall be fined an amount not
22	to exceed \$500 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months <u>2 years</u> , or both.
23	(3) The district court shall have has exclusive jurisdiction in prosecutions under this section. Any
24	action for official misconduct must be commenced by an information filed after leave to file has been
25	granted by the district court or after a grand jury indictment has been found.
26	(4) A public servant who has been charged as provided in subsection (3) may be suspended from
27	his office without pay pending final judgment. Upon final judgment of conviction, he the public servant shall
28	permanently forfeit his the office. Upon acquittal <u>, he the public servant</u> shall must be reinstated in his the
29	office and shall must receive all backpay.
30	(5) This section does not affect any power conferred by law to impeach or remove any public



1 servant or any proceeding authorized by law to carry into effect such the impeachment or removal."
