Prior to the passage of HB 518 by the 54th Legislature, temporary permits were issued to new applicants while awaiting the results of the FBI fingerprints and completion of the application for licensure.
- 2. The passage of HB 447 would allow for the issuance of a "temporary identification card for apprentice" which is the same process of issuing a temporary permit.
- 3. Any costs incurred in the issuance and tracking of "apprentices" will be absorbed in the appropriation contained in HB 2 for the Board of Private Security and Patrol Officers.
