12	WHEREAS, agriculture is Montana's largest industry, and beef livestock is Montana's largest cash
13	crop; and
14	WHEREAS, bison in Yellowstone National Park are the responsibility of the federal government; and
15	WHEREAS, brucellosis is a disease that causes undulant fever in humans and that causes cattle to
16	abort; and
17	WHEREAS, the federal government has stated that brucellosis can be transmitted from bison to
18	cattle; and
19	WHEREAS, the Montana livestock industry has spent \$30 million to eradicate brucellosis in Montana
20	and to obtain a brucellosis-free status and, after a 40-year industry battle to eradicate brucellosis
21	nationwide, the Legislature is alarmed that the federal government has abdicated its responsibility to combat
22	the disease in a herd owned by the people of the United States; and
23	WHEREAS, the federal government has stated that if infected bison enter the state, Montana stands
24	to lose its brucellosis-free status; and
25	WHEREAS, the federal government is exposing the citizens of Montana and their livestock to
26	brucellosis infection by its failure to adequately manage diseased bison in Yellowstone National Park; and
27	WHEREAS, the only proposals presented to the Governor by the federal agencies have been
28	inadequate to resolve the problem, and the Legislature has grave doubts about the intent, purpose, and
29	implications of previously prepared federal proposals.
