5	TO FILL VACANT ELECTED POSITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 7-4-2206, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
6	IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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1.0	Section 1. Section 7-4-2206, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"7-4-2206. Vacancies. (1) For the purposes of this part, "vacancy" has the same meaning as
12	prescribed in 2-16-501.
13	(2) Vacancies in all county offices, except that of county commissioner, shall must be filled by
14	appointment by the board of county commissioners. Except as provided in subsections (3) through (5) for
15	the justice of the peace, the appointee shall hold his the office, if elective, until the person elected at the
16	next general election qualifies for and assumes the office. unless otherwise provided in subsection (3) or
17	(4), and if If the office is not elective, the appointee serves at the pleasure of the commissioners.
18	(3) Whenever a vacancy occurs 75 days or more before the general election held during the second
19	year of the term, an individual shall must be elected to complete the term at that general election. The
20	election procedure to be used to elect the successor is as follows:
21	(a) Whenever the vacancy occurs 75 days or more before the primary election during the second
22	year of the term, the same procedure shall must be utilized used as is used to elect a person to that office
23	for a full 4-year term.
24	(b) Whenever the vacancy occurs after the 75th day preceding before the primary election, any
25	political party desiring to enter a candidate in the general election shall select a candidate as provided in
26	13-38-204. A political party shall notify the clerk and recorder of the party nominee. A person desiring
27	to be a candidate as an independent shall follow the procedures provided in 13-10-501 and 13-10-502.
28	The petition for an independent candidate shall must be filed with the clerk and recorder on or before the
29	75th day prior to before the general election. A candidate for a nonpartisan office shall file as provided in

Title 13, chapter 14.

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1	(4) Whenever a vacancy occurs after the 75th day preceding before the general election held during
2	the second year of the term, the person appointed by the commissioners under 7-4-2206(2) subsection (2)
3	shall serve until the end of the term.
4	(5) Vacancies occurring in the office of justice of the peace shall must be filled as provided in Title
5	3, chapter 10, part 2."
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7	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
