10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	
12	Section 1. Section 70-16-206, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"70-16-206. Partition fences required — adjoining lands previously enclosed. The occupants of
14	adjoining lands enclosed with fonces must shall build and maintain throughout the year partition fences
15	between their own and the next adjoining enclosure land in equal shares so long as both continuo to
16	enclose the same, and such partition fence must be kept in good repair throughout the year unless the
17	occupants otherwise mutually agree unless the occupant of the adjoining land chooses to let the land lie
18	idle. The occupants are then governed by 70-16-210 unless otherwise mutually agreed upon."
19	
20	Section 2. Section 81-4-201, MCA, is amended to read:
21	"81-4-201. Animals running at large. It is unlawful for an owner or person in control of swine,
22	sheep, llamas, alpacas, bison, ostriches, rheas, emus, or goats to willfully permit the animals to run at large.
23	An owner or person in control of these animals is not considered to be willfully permitting the animals to
24	be running at large if the owner or person in control is in compliance with 70-16-205."

26	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
