DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill for an act entitled, "An act for formalizing the operation of the Water Information System within the Natural Resource Information System at the State Library, and amending sections 85-2-112 which enacts this act, and 90-15-303 to include the Natural Resource Information System in interagency cooperation.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Natural Resource Information System, at the Montana State Library has been providing the water information system since the program was created. This legislation clarifies the language as to who is actually providing the service.
- 2. Functions of the Environmental Quality Council, in the Committees & Activities Program, would not be substantially altered or increased by requirements of this bill.
- 3. The Environmental Quality Council could complete duties specified in the revised section within current funding levels.
- 4. There is no fiscal impact to Department of Natural Resources.
