10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article XI of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by adding a new
section that reads:

14 Section 10. Mandated programs. The state shall not mandate or assign any new, expanded, or 15 modified programs or responsibilities to any political subdivision in a way that necessitates additional local 16 expenditures by the political subdivision unless the programs or responsibilities are fully funded by the state 17 or unless the programs or responsibilities are approved for funding by a vote of the qualified electorate or 18 the local legislative body of the political subdivision.

20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Submission to electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the 21 qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 1998 by printing on the ballot 22 the full title of this act and the following:

FOR prohibiting state-imposed mandates on political subdivisions unless funded by the state
or approved by the political subdivision's electorate or local legislative body.
