Section 20-6-621, MCA, is amended to read: "20-6-621. Selection of school sites, approval election, and lease of state lands. (1) The trustees 12 13 of a district may select the sites for school buildings or for other school purposes, but the selection must 14 first be approved by the qualified electors of the district before a contract for the purchase of a site is 15 entered into by the trustees<sub>7</sub>, except However, the trustees may purchase or otherwise acquire property 16 contiguous to an existing site that is in use for school purposes without a site approval election. The 17 trustees may take an option on a site prior to the site approval election. 18 (2) The election for the approval of a site must be called under the provisions of 20-20-201 and 19 must be conducted in the manner prescribed by this title for school elections. An elector who may vote at 20 a school site election if the elector is qualified to vote under the provisions of 20-20-301. If a majority of 21 those voting at the election approve the site selection, the trustees may purchase the site. A site approval 22 election is not required when the site was specifically identified in an election at which an additional levy 23 or the issuance of bonds was approved for the purchase of the site. 24

- (3) Any site for a school building or other building of the district that is selected or purchased by the trustees must:
  - (a) be in a place that is convenient, accessible, and suitable;
- (b) comply with the minimum size and other requirements prescribed by the department of public health and human services; and
- (c) comply with the statewide building regulations, if any, promulgated by the department of commerce.



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1	(4) The board of land commissioners may sell, at the appraised value, or lease for any period of
2	time less than 99 years, at an amount of \$1 per a year, to a district any tract of state land of not more
3	than <u>:</u>
4	(a) 10 20 acres to be used as a sehool site in the district for an elementary school; or
5	(b) 50 acres to be used as a site in the district for a high school."
