## Fiscal Note for SB0168, as introduced

# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill for an act creating an offense of domestic terrorism; providing a penalty for domestic terrorism; and providing an immediate effective date and an applicability date.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- Current law allows felony prosecution of offenders who cause damage to property in excess of \$500.
- 2. This bill creates a felony offense for property damage under \$500 if the person purposely or knowingly committed the act for the purpose of influencing the policy or conduct of the state or any political subdivision of the state.
- 3. The Department of Corrections (DOC) assumes that there will be two offenders per year sentenced under this penalty.
- 4. The DOC assumes that these offenders will be sentenced to 10 years of imprisonment but will serve 34% (3.4 years) of this sentence.
- 5. Average cost per day at Montana State Prison including outside medical costs is \$44.47.
