# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing certain counselors to take an examination for licensure as a licensed professional counselor.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

#### Department of Commerce/POL Bureau:

- 1. There will be 14 counselors employed by community mental health centers on July 1, 1997, who will apply for examination as a licensed professional counselor.
- The applicants will pay the national testing agency directly for the costs of the examination.
- 3. The processing of 14 applications and the issuance of licenses to candidates successfully passing the examination can be absorbed by existing staff and within the budget as presented in the 1999 biennium Executive Budget.
- 4. The estimated 14 applicants will each submit \$50 to make application and \$50 for an original license, for a total projected revenue of \$1,400 in fiscal year 1998. They will pay a \$50 renewal fee by December 31, 1998, for projected revenue of \$700 in fiscal year 1999.
