# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill will allow members of the Teachers' Retirement System (TRS), with prior employment with the Montana University System Extension Service to purchase more than 5 years of service for the service with the cooperative extension program.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Under current law, TRS members are not required to pay the actuarial cost to purchase up to five years of service with the Montana Cooperative Extension Service.
- 2. TRS members eligible to purchase service under this proposal will pay the full actuarial cost to purchase any service with the Montana Cooperative Extension Service in excess of five years.
- 3. The actuarial cost will be based on the member's age, years of credited service with TRS plus any service the member is eligible to qualify, and the current actuarial assumptions in effect at the time the member purchases the service.
- 4. Administrative costs for the Teachers' Retirement Division for data processing system enhancements are estimated to not exceed \$1,800.
- 5. Under the Internal Revenue Code Section 415(c), annual contributions to purchase additional service is limited to the lesser of \$30,000 or 25 percent of the members taxable income.
- E. If the member pays the full actuarial cost of any enhanced benefit resulting from the purchase of Montana extension service in excess of five years, this option will not increase the unfunded liabilities of the system or extend the amortization period required to fund current liabilities.

compensation multiplied by the sum of the number of years of creditable service, service transferred under
19-20-409, and additional service purchased under 19-20-412.
(2) Any <u>Except as provided in subsection (3), a</u> retired member may be employed as a part-time
or substitute teacher in Montana and may earn, without loss of retirement benefits, an amount not to
exceed the greater of:
(a)—one-third of the sum of his <u>the member's</u> average final compensation plus normal annual salar $\gamma$
increases for teaching personnel employed by the school-district, state agency, political subdivision, or
university unit that employed the member at the time of retirement; or
(b) one-third of the median of the average final compensation for members retired during the
