

14	vesting of a property right for owners of alcoholic beverage licenses; and
15	WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 354, if passed and approved, would establish a new category of beer
16	and wine license to allow restaurants to serve beer and wine to patrons and would represent a significant
17	modification to the quota system; and
18	WHEREAS, the effects of Senate Bill No. 354, if enacted, on the existing quota system are
19	unknown; and
20	WHEREAS, the Legislature has not undertaken a systematic evaluation of the alcoholic beverage
21	quota system.

23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
24	STATE OF MONTANA:
25	That the Revenue Oversight Committee be requested to:
26	(1) monitor the issuance and administration of the new beer and wine licenses;
27	(2) review the existing quota system related to the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises
28	consumption;
29	(3) monitor the changes in the value of existing licenses to determine whether the issuance of the
30	new beer and wine licenses has an effect on the value of existing licenses;
