Montana Fair Housing is a private, full service, non-profit organization dedicated to the elimination of housing discrimination, and the advancement of civil rights. Call Montana Fair Housing (MFH) if you think your rights have been violated. They can investigate your complaint and potentially identify information to support your allegations, assist you in filing a complaint of housing discrimination with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and/or the Montana Human Rights Bureau (HRB), and under certain circumstances MFH can dispute resolution services prior to the filing of a formal complaint with HUD and/or the HRB.

### Statute of Limitations on Complaints/Lawsuits

According to MFH, if you think your rights have been violated, you have one year after an alleged violation to file a complaint with the Department of Housing and Urban Development. A complaint must be filed with the Montana Human Rights Bureau within 180 days of the alleged violation.

According to MFH, you may file a lawsuit, at your expense, in Federal District Court within two years of an alleged violation. You may bring your suit even after filing a complaint with HUD and/or HRB, if you have not signed a conciliation agreement and an Administrative Law Judge has not started a hearing. A court may award actual and punitive damages and attorney's fees and costs.
