On April 22, 2025, the Defendant was sentenced as follows: Count I: Eighty (80) years to the Montana State Prison under §46-18-201 MCA, for the offense of Deliberate Homicide, a Felony, in violation of §45-5-102(1)(b), MCA. Count II: Twenty (20) years to the Montana State Prison under §46-18-201, MCA, for the offense of Negligent Homicide, a Felony, in violation of §45-5-104, MCA, to run consecutively to Count I. The Defendant was given credit for time spent in pre-trial incarceration as follows: December 1, 2023 through April 22, 2025. The Court ordered the Defendant to pay restitution, joint and several with the Co-Defendants in DC-24-1531 and DC-23-1587, in the total amount of Six Thousand One Hundred Sixty dollars (\$6,160.00). The Court granted the State’s oral motion to dismiss Count III. The Court recommended that for any period of community supervision (parole) that the Defendant not knowingly have any contact, oral, written, electronic or through a third party, with R.P., R.C., and K.M.’s family (the victims and/or the victim’s immediate family).

On February 5, 2026, the Defendant's Application for review of that sentence came on for hearing by Zoom videoconference before the Sentence Review Division of the Montana Supreme Court (hereafter “the Division”). The Defendant appeared from the Montana State Prison and was represented by Rufus Peace, Defense Counsel. The State was not represented. The Defendant did give a statement.

Before hearing the Application, the Defendant was advised that the Division has the authority not only to reduce the sentence or affirm it but also increase it. The Defendant was

further advised that there is no appeal from a decision of the Division. The Defendant acknowledged that he understood this and stated that he wished to proceed.

Rule 12, Rules of the Sentence Review Division of the Supreme Court of Montana, provides that, "The sentence imposed by the District Court is presumed correct. The sentence shall not be reduced or increased unless it is clearly inadequate or clearly excessive." (Section 46-18-904(3), MCA).

The Division finds that the reasons advanced for modification are insufficient to hold that the sentence imposed by the District Court is clearly inadequate or clearly excessive.

Therefore, it is the Majority decision of the Division that the sentence is AFFIRMED.
