
Direct Appeals

1st Quarter 2023 Highlights

- * Case Clearance rates increased from 102% to 118% between Quarter 4, 2022 and Quarter 1, 2023.
- * In Quarter 1, 2023 10% of Direct Appeal and Original Proceeding cases were over 180 days.
- * Time to Disposition rates for Direct Appeals decreased by 8 days and remained steady for Original Proceedings in Quarter 1, 2023.

Direct Appeal Lifecycle - Median Days by Case Type

- Median Days from Notice of Appeal to Court
- Median Days from Date Sent to Court to Classification
- Median Days from Classification to Remittitur



Case Clearance: The ratio between the number of cases closed (outgoing) and the number of cases filed (incoming).

Manner of Disposition: The manner by which the Court disposes of its cases.

Original Proceedings

Age of Pending Cases: The age of the Court's active cases (does not include stayed cases).

Time to Disposition: The length of time (median days) it takes the Court to dispose of cases.
