


### 3rd Quarter 2025 Highlights

- \* The Percentage of Current Direct Appeal Cases increased from 91% to 95% from Q2 to Q3.
- \* Case Clearance rates increased from 89% in Q2 2025 to 118% in Q3 2025.
- \* The Time to Disposition rate remained steady for Direct Appeals and increased slightly for Original Proceedings.



### Direct Appeal Lifecycle - Median Days by Case Type

- Median Days from Notice of Appeal to Court
- Median Days from Date Sent to Court to Classification
- Median Days from Classification to Remittitur



**Case Clearance:** The ratio between the number of cases closed (outgoing) and the number of cases filed (incoming). **Manner of Disposition**: The manner by which the Court disposes of its cases.

**Age of Pending Cases:** The age of the Court's active cases (does not include stayed cases). **Time to Disposition:** The length of time (median days) it takes the Court to dispose of cases.
