**NOTICE OF CSKT COMPACT FINAL ORDER
AND DISMISSAL OF OBJECTIONS**

The Water Court entered its Final Order approving the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation—State of Montana—United States Compact (the “Compact” or “CSKT Compact”) into final decrees of the Water Court (“Final Order”). As part of the Final Order, the Court dismissed all remaining objections to the Compact.

The Final Order includes the Water Court’s certification of a final order pursuant to Montana Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b) for purposes of the time for any appeal.

Simultaneous with the Final Order, the Court also entered an Order Providing Notice of Post-Decree Abstracts (“Abstract Notice Order”). The Abstract Notice Order includes post-decree versions of each water right abstract included in the Compact and approved by the Water Court for inclusion in final decrees of the Water Court.

The Final Order and the Abstract Notice Order may be accessed on the Court's Full Court Enterprise system for this case. The orders also are accessible on the Final Orders section of the Water Court's website at <https://courts.mt.gov/courts/water/CSKT/>.
