The meeting of the Joint Subcommittee on Education was called to order by Chairman Gene Donaldson on Wednesday, January 9, 1985, at 9:00 A.M. in Room 104 of the State Capitol.

Roll Call: The roll was called and all members were present.

Chairman Donaldson announced the following schedule changes.

On Friday, January 11, the Education Subcommittee will attend a meeting of the Long Range Planning Committee at 8:00 A.M. at the old Supreme Court Building. At this meeting a bonding issue will be reviewed. At approximately 9:00 A.M. on that same day the Education Subcommittee will have a brief work session.

The Work Study Program will not be discussed on Monday, January 14, and will be re-scheduled for a later date.

Those topics originally scheduled for discussion on Wednesday, January 23, will be discussed on Wednesday, January 16. The topics are School Lunch, Transportation, Traffic Education, Secondary Vo-Ed and Special Education.

Bill Sykes of the Legislative Fiscal Analyst's Office gave a brief review of the agencies which will be discussed on Thursday, January 9. (2:A:117) Those agencies are the Board of Public Education, Fire Services Training School and the Vo-Ed Advisory Council.

A general discussion followed.
