January 9, 1985

The first meeting of the Senate Education and Cultural Resources Committee was called to order by the Chairman, Senator Chet Blaylock, at 1:05 p.m. in Room 402, State Capitol Building.


ROLL CALL: All committee members were present.

Senator Blaylock had the members of the committee introduce themselves. He also introduced the Committee Secretary, Jill Rohyans, and the Committee Researcher from Legislative Council, Lee Heiman.

Senator Blaylock announced that Superintendent of Public Instruction Ed Argenbright will again be coordinating student presentations to the committee as had been done in previous sessions under the then Chairman Senator Brown. Senator Blaylock has invited Superintendent Argenbright to expand the program this session to include both students and adults working in the system.

Senator Blaylock introduced Bill Anderson, Assistant Superintendent of Public Instruction who spoke briefly to the committee. He introduced several OPI staff members, Bob Stockton, State Aid and Transportation Director, Judy Johnson, Assistant Superintendent for Special Services, Gene Christiaansen, Assistant Superintendent for Vocational Education Services, and Bob Anderson, Assistant Superintendent for Basic Skills. He also announced John Larson, formerly Secretary of the Senate, will be a part time advisor to OPI regarding legislative issues. Mr. Anderson invited committee members to use the OPI telephone conference room at their convenience.
