

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

April 10, 1985

The Conference Committee on Senate Bill 221 was called to order by Chairman Dick Manning at 1 p.m. in Room 331, Capitol.

ROLL CALL: The members consisted of Senator Manning, Chairman, Senator Lynch, Senator Gage, Representative Pavlovich, Representative Driscoll, Representative Glaser and Representative Schultz. All the members were present with the exception of Senator Lynch.

The members met and discussed Senate Bill 221 and their problems with it. Mr. Steve Meloy, Executive Secretary of the Horse Racing Board was present at the meeting.

The members decided that the amendments were just fine the way they were. Senator Manning made a motion that the amendments be left the way they were. Question was called and the Conference Committee voted unanimously that the motion be adopted.

Senator Manning moved that the Conference Committee on Senate Bill 221 be dissolved. The motion passed unanimously.
