

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

April 15, 1985

The Conference Committee on House Bill 127 was called to order by Chairman Bob Williams at 11:50 a.m. in Room 331, Capitol.

ROLL CALL: Members present were Senator Bob Williams, Chairman, Senator Halligan, Representative Driscoll and Representative Glaser. Senator Gage, Representative Kadas and Representative Keyser were absent.

The members met and discussed House Bill 127 and the proposed amendments of Representative Keyser. After a general discussion of the problems with the bill as written and the proposed amendments it was decided that they would dissolve the Conference Committee and request a Free Conference Committee to deal with a new proposed amendment to House Bill 127.
