

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE ON SENATE BILL 215  
MONTANA STATE SENATE

April 16, 1985

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 noon by Chairman Jack Haffey in Room 331, Capitol.

ROLL CALL: The Conference Committee members are Senator Haffey, Senator Yellowtail, Senator Anderson, Representative Ramirez, Representative Addy, Representative Harper, and Representative Thomas. They were all present.

Senator Yellowtail made a motion that the House recede from all the amendments to Senate Bill 215.

Representative Ramirez asked that that motion be divided into four parts--one for each set of amendments.

The first set of amendments discussed were the "Bud Campbell" amendments. Question was called, and with Representative Thomas voting no, the motion passed.

The next set of amendments discussed were the "Rapp-Svrcek" amendments. Representative Addy made a substitute motion that these amendments be acceded to by the Senate. Question was called, and the motion passed unanimously.

There was much discussion regarding the "Brown" amendments. Senator Yellowtail reaffirmed his motion that the House recede from the amendments. Question was called and with the Senate voting 3 in favor of the motion and 0 against, and the House voting 2 in favor of the motion and 2 against, the amendments will go to the House floor without a recommendation; and to the Senate recommending adoption of the motion.

The Conferees next discussed the "Winslow" amendments. Once again, the original motion was set forth. Question was called and with the Senate voting 2 in favor of the motion and 1 against, and the House voting 2 in favor of the motion and 2 against, the report will be submitted to the House without a recommendation; and to the Senate recommending adoption of the motion.
