FREE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE ON SENATE BILL 431

The free Conference Committee on Senate Bill 431 was called to order at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 1985, by Chairman Les Hirsch.

Members of the Committee are: Senator Hirsch, Senator Mazurek, Senator McCallum, Representative Gould, Representative Ramirez, Representative Ream, and Representative Schye. All the members were present.

1. Representative Ramirez moved his amendments #1 and #9. Question was called and the Committee voted unanimously to adopt amendments #1 and #9.

2. Senator McCallum moved amendment #3. Question was called and with Senator Hirsch and Representative Schye voting no, amendment #3 was adopted.

3. Amendment #4 was withdrawn.

4. Amendment #5 was withdrawn.

5. Amendment #6 hereinafter referred to as the Ream amendment (See Exhibit #2) was changed to read: Parcels that do not meet the qualifications set out in subsections 1 shall not be classified or valued as agricultural if they are part of a platted subdivision that is filed with the county clerk and recorder. Senator Ramirez moved the Ream amendment as amended. Question called, and the Committee voted unanimously that the Ream amendment be adopted as amended.

6. Representative Gould moved amendment #7. Question called, Committee voted unanimously to adopt amendment #7.

7. Amendment #8 withdrawn.

8. Amendment #10 withdrawn.

9. Representative Gould moved his amendment which was defeated.
