Executive Action: DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND REHABILITATIVE  
SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES,  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL  
SCIENCES AND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND  
INDUSTRY.

CHAIRMAN COBB explained the day's agenda and the executive action  
which would be taken.

**SUPPLEMENTALS - FISCAL 1993**

**HOUSE BILL 3 EXHIBIT 1**

**Motion:** SEN. WATERMAN moved that, when a motion is made to  
eliminate a program, public testimony, not including questioning,  
be allowed.

**Substitute Motion/Vote:** CHAIRMAN COBB moved that the committee  
allow limited testimony before a vote on the big cuts. Motion  
CARRIED with CHAIRMAN COBB and REP. KASTEN voting no.

Substitute Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB moved that the committee not take public testimony next week after having finished.

REP. WANZENRIED asked that the committee be allowed to consider a positive motion.

Amended Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB changed the motion to state that the committee would have a public hearing next week following executive action.

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB restated the amended motion. Motion CARRIED with SEN. WATERMAN and SEN. CHRISTIAENS voting no.

Lois Steinbeck, Legislative Fiscal Analyst, explained the format for discussing supplementals.

#### Department of Health and Environmental Sciences

CHAIRMAN COBB stated the committee would begin with DHES, first ensuring that committee members understand the supplemental, then taking testimony.

#### Water Quality - Subdivision

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved that the supplemental for the Water Quality Subdivision, general fund of \$145,962 be approved. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

#### Department of Labor and Industry

#### Employment Relations

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved that the Employment Relations, other funds \$125,000 be approved. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

#### Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services

#### Medicaid Primary Care

Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB moved that the committee accept the Medicaid primary care supplemental for \$8.4 million general fund and \$20.0 million other funds.

#### Discussion:

Ms. Steinbeck clarified that the motion would address what is currently in HB 3, but would not address amendments requested by SRS.

REP. KASTEN asked whether CHAIRMAN COBB'S motion was for just \$28 million.

CHAIRMAN COBB answered that his motion covered \$8.4 million general funds and \$20 million other funds. Each one of those is a separate motion.

Vote: Motion CARRIED unanimously.

Reduced Savings - Passport to Health:

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept the Supplemental Passport to Health. Motion FAILED with REP. COBB, SEN. WATERMAN, SEN. KEATING voting yes and SEN. CHRISTIAENS, REP. KASTEN, and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

Nursing Home Increase:

Motion: SEN. KEATING moved to accept the nursing home increase at the requested amendment level.

Substitute Motion: SEN. CHRISTIAENS made a substitute motion to accept the nursing home increase for only one-half of the amount which would be approximately \$160,000 from the general fund, and \$1 million of other funds.

REP. KASTEN said that she would oppose this motion because a user tax should not be used for other programs.

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB repeated the substitute motion that accepted the supplemental nursing home increase for half the amount-- \$115,174 in general fund and other funds of \$1.4 million. Motion FAILED with SEN. WATERMAN, SEN. CHRISTIAENS and REP. WANZENRIED voting yes, and CHAIRMAN COBB, SEN. KEATING, and REP. KASTEN voting no.

Original Motion: SEN. KEATING amended his original motion on the nursing home increase to the original amendments, \$231,948 of general fund and \$2.8 million other funds; and add the nursing home reimbursement of \$749,309.

Vote: Motion CARRIED. SEN. CHRISTIAENS and REP. WANZENRIED voted no.

FY 92 Primary Care

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved approval of FY 92 primary care supplemental \$1,008,795 general fund and \$2,604,779 other funds. Motion CARRIED with REP. KASTEN voting no.

AFDC Benefits

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to approve AFDC benefits of \$1,069,723 general fund monies and \$1,094,074 other funds. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

General Assistance Benefits

Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept the general assistance benefits supplemental of \$368,072 general fund.

Vote: Motion CARRIED with SEN. KEATING and REP. KASTEN voting no.

TEAMS - Data Processing

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept the supplemental for TEAMS - data processing, \$175,000 general fund and \$325,000 other funds. Motion CARRIED with REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

Teams - Postage

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept the supplemental for TEAMS - postage, \$77,279 general fund and \$119,721 other funds. Motion CARRIED with REP. KASTEN voting no.

AFDC Day Care Benefits

Motion/Vote: REP. KEATING moved to accept the supplemental AFDC day care benefits. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

Nurse's Aide Registry

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept the supplemental nurse's aide registry with \$82,721 general fund and \$82,721 other funds. Motion FAILED with CHAIRMAN COBB, REP. KASTEN, and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

Meds Contract

Motion/Vote: REP. KEATING made a motion to accept the MEDS contract, \$65,000 general fund and \$65,000 other funds. Motion CARRIED unanimously

Legal Services Program

Motion/Vote: SEN. WATERMAN moved that the committee approve a supplemental of \$50,000 from general fund to use in the Legal Services program for the remainder of this biennium. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

Vocational Rehabilitation

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept the supplemental for Vocational Rehabilitation for \$71,219 general fund and to reduce the other funds by the same amount. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

SRS Support Services Division  
Correct Fund Mix

Motion/Vote: SEN. WATERMAN moved to accept the correct fund mix in the SRS Support Division of \$213,200 from the general fund. Motion CARRIED with CHAIRMAN COBB and SEN. KEATING voting no.

SRS Support Services Division  
Partially Restore Special Session II Reductions

Motion/Vote: SEN. CHRISTIAENS moved that the committee partially restore Special Session II reductions of \$75,300 from the general fund. Motion FAILED with CHAIRMAN COBB, SEN. KEATING, REP. KASTEN, and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

Federal Match for DFS Youth Psychiatric Benefits

SEN. KEATING asked whether this item was for spending authority only or whether these funds are available?

Dr. Blouke answered that these are federal funds for the general fund match in the DFS.

CHAIRMAN COBB suggested that the \$6.8 million related to foster care, inpatient youth psychiatric care, and residential youth psychiatric care would be more appropriately voted on when the committee addresses the Department of Family Services.

Department of Family Services

Pine Hills Schools and Mountain View School

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved that the committee accept the supplementals of \$189,244 for Pine Hills and \$15,000 for Mountain View School from the general fund. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

Foster Care

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved that the committee accept the foster care supplemental for \$1.2 million and also the requested amendments for \$1.0 million; for a total of \$2.218,171 of general fund monies. Motion CARRIED with SEN. KEATING and REP. KASTEN voting no.

Inpatient Youth Psychiatric

Motion/Vote: SEN. WATERMAN moved to accept the supplemental on inpatient psychiatric, including the federal match and general fund of \$2,027,411. Motion CARRIED with CHAIRMAN COBB and REP. KASTEN voting no.

Residential Youth Psychiatric

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept the supplemental for residential youth psychiatric for \$2,590,252 of general fund plus the federal match for SRS. Motion CARRIED with CHAIRMAN COBB and REP. KASTEN voting no.

CHAIRMAN COBB stated that the committee would consider the first eight of the 1995 Biennium Reductions, Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services, Attachment 1, Governor Racicot's modifications. Number Six to reduce general funded positions, will be done the following day after all programs have been considered.

CHAIRMAN COBB started with #1 to restrict emergency assistance by \$50,000 general fund and \$86,505 federal funds.

Restrict Emergency Assistance

Motion/Vote: SEN. CHRISTIAENS moved to adopt #1. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

CHAIRMAN COBB moved to #2 which is to reduce outpatient hospital reimbursement - \$115,368 general fund and \$278,443 federal funds.

Reduce Outpatient Hospital Reimbursement

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept #2. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

CHAIRMAN COBB asked the committee to consider #3 which is bid oxygen services - \$175,440 general fund and \$431,618 of federal funds.

Bid Oxygen

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept #3. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

CHAIRMAN COBB moved to #4 which is to eliminate payments for AFDC minor in home - \$472,092 general fund and \$1,161,444 of federal funds.

Eliminate Payments for AFDC Minor in Home

Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB moved that instead of eliminating payments for the AFDC minor at home, the department be required to charge child support on the parents of the AFDC minor. CHAIRMAN COBB stated that his motion was contingent on passage of REP. BOHARSKI'S bill.

Substitute Motion: CHAIRMAN COBB explained that the substitute motion is contingent on REP. BOHARSKI'S bill passing; parents of

minors living on their own and receiving AFDC be charged. The general fund savings of this amount will go into House Bill 2.

Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB called for a vote. The substitute motion CARRIED unanimously.

#### Recalculate Out-of-State Hospital Payments

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept #5, recalculate out-of state hospital payments - \$475,592 general fund and \$1,150,423 other funds. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

#### Non-assumed Counties TEAMS Costs

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept #7, the non-assumed counties TEAMS costs - \$700,000 general fund. Motion CARRIED unanimously.

#### Include \$50 Rent Subsidy in AFDC Payment

Motion/Vote: SEN. KEATING moved to accept #8, \$50 rent subsidy in AFDC payment - \$1,356,030 general fund and \$3,336,116 of federal funds. Motion FAILED with SEN. WATERMAN, SEN. CHRISTIAENS, and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

#### Executive Action: Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services and Department of Family Services

##### Budget Reductions

#### Transfer Poor Fund Administration Back to Assumed Counties

##### SRS Duties

##### DFS Duties

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB explained that the savings to SRS is \$9,300,000 and the savings to DFS is \$5,400,000. CHAIRMAN COBB moved to accept the transfer of poor fund administration to assumed counties, based on SEN. KEATING'S bill passing, that assumed counties return back to non-assumed. Motion CARRIED with SEN. CHRISTIAENS and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.

#### Payment of Medically Needy Contingent on Passing of HB 309

Motion/Vote: REP. KASTEN moved payment of medically needy, contingent on passage of HB 309. Motion CARRIED unanimously.


CHAIRMAN COBB suggested that the committee skip #3, Racicot amendments, with exception of 5% personal services cuts, because action has already been taken on part of the Racicot amendments.

Cap Growth of Medicaid Primary Care

Motion/Vote: CHAIRMAN COBB moved to cap the growth of Medicaid primary care around \$3.0 million. Motion **FAILED** with SEN. WATERMAN, SEN. CHRISTIAENS, and REP. WANZENRIED voting no.
